The SDEC Unit at West Suffolk Hospital provides same day emergency care. This means that patients are assessed, diagnosed, treated and able to go home on the same day without having to stay in hospital overnight. The process can take a few hours. The pathway below gives detail on what you can expect to happen in our SDEC unit.





Assessment









Arrival

You may have been referred to SDEC by the emergency department, your GP, the ambulance service, a hospital ward, outpatient clinic or other healthcare facility. Please make yourself known to reception you may need. when you arrive.

Your first assessment will be carried out by a healthcare practitioner. This allows us to determine the best place for you to be seen and some of the tests / investigations

Investigation

This could be blood pressure, blood tests. x-rays or other scans. We will begin your investigations as soon as we can.

A healthcare practitioner will assess you and decide a treatment plan based on their findings.

Review

Further tests or possible senior review

Sometimes we may need to do some more investigations and your clinician may need advice from a specialist to help to decide the best treatment plan for you.

Home

We always aim to get you home the same day with a treatment plan in place.
